

## **HIERARCHY OF THE VALUE OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS**

### **SUMMARY**

Keywords: hierarchy of values, young people, social rehabilitation, value system, correctional institutions.

**The subject** of the dissertation research was the occurrence of values in resocialization work towards young people staying in correctional institutions, and the analysis of links between the quality of the relationship between the educator and the pupil and possible relationships, which in consequence should be designed to lead to a change in the life attitudes of a young person.

**The aim of this study** is to analyze the hierarchy of value for you in the rehabilitation process in correctional facilities.

#### **Objectives of these details:**

**Theoretical goal:** Developing the concept of resocialization work based on the hierarchy is worth it.

In the surveys, the selection of respondents was made using a random method. In total, a mixed version was used: random-targeted. It would be expedient to select such individuals in which the girl wants to conduct research on groups of wasps (girls of both boys and boys).
